



HEAD-TO-TOE CHECKLIST

Before you leave home:



Hair:

- Tightly secured up in a bun. No bangs, flyways, etc.
- **Toddler, Level 1&2 Combo, Jazz Mini, Pre-Teen Combo, Ballet 1, Tap/Jazz 1, Hip Hop Mini, Hip Hop 1, Musical Theatre 1:**
Bun at crown of head, foam hair donut encouraged.
- **Ballet 2+, Tap/Jazz 2+, Hip Hop 2+, Musical Theatre 2+:**
Center part, bun straight back from ears, no hair donut.
- Dancers in multiple levels should follow ballet level bun.
Performing Team members wear low bun regardless of level.
- Encouraged: bobby pins, gel, hair spray, hair net.
- Not permitted: barrettes, clips, bows, ribbons, glitter hairspray.
- Tutorial available on website.
- **Males:** hair must be neatly combed back with a side or center part & secured with hairspray, gel, and/or bobby pins. All hair must stay off of face & neck while dancing. Long hair must be gathered into a low bun with side part.

Hair piece notes:

Shoes:

- Remember to bring the style of shoes needed for each dance!

Shoe notes (style, socks, etc):

Make-Up:

- **Required for students of all ages.**
- Important with bright stage lights!
- **Eyes:** blue eyeshadow (mascara & eyeliner optional for older dancers)
- **Cheeks:** pink blush
- **Lips:** red lip stain. Covergirl Outlast #830 Classic Red or Lipsense in BluRed are strongly encouraged.
- **Males:** natural eye shadow & blush, lip stain (a shade darker than lips). Ben Nye stage make-up kit encouraged.
- Tip: Wear a button or zip-up shirt to avoid messing up hair & make-up when changing.

Accessories:

- All jewelry must be removed. If ears have recently been pierced, they need to be covered with skin-tone Band-Aids.
- Wedding/promise rings are the only exception.
- **No nail polish** (barefoot dancers - don't forget toes!)
- Eyeglasses are not permitted on stage. Talk with your instructor if you have concerns.
- **NO UNDERWEAR** under tights or costume. Potty training toddlers wear a pull-up.
- Nude leotards are strongly encouraged for dancers with backstage costume changes.
- If bras are necessary for dancers, they must be nude in color, have clear straps, and not show outside of the nude leotard.

When you arrive:

(Picture Day, Dress Rehearsal, Showcase)

Costume:

- Try on **ONE TIME** at home, then **LABEL** all costume pieces & accessories.
- Do not leave costume crumpled in bag at home.
Hang tutus upside down in a steamy bathroom to relax wrinkles. Do not get wet.
- Do not use safety pins to alter costumes.
Needle & thread or velcro dots are allowed.
- **Arrive at all events in street clothes, carrying costume in protective bag.**
- **Change out of costume and return it to the protective bag before leaving any event.**
The only exception is the final show - feel free to wear it out and celebrate!
- **NO** replacement costumes if your costume is damaged before the showcase.
- **ONLY NON-MESSY SNACKS AND WATER SHOULD BE CONSUMED WHILE IN COSTUME.**

Tights:

- **A new pair of tights has been included in your costume bag.** Reserve these tights for Picture Day, Dress Rehearsal and the Showcase.
- Extras are available for purchase backstage in case of emergency.

Bag:

- **Each student must bring a stiff-sided stand up bag** (i.e. brown paper grocery bag) with their name and class written on it to hold personal items while at the theater.
- **LABEL EVERYTHING IN THIS BAG!**

PACKING (and labeling!) LIST:

- Costume
- Hairpieces
- Any other accessories (gloves, etc)
- Tights
- Shoes
- Make-up (for touch-ups)
- Hair tools (for touch-ups)
- Clothes to wear home
- Personal items like coloring book, stuffy, blanket, etc.
- Technology devices like iPads are permitted, but wifi is not available and Legacy is not responsible for lost/stolen items.
- **Leak proof water bottles are encouraged.**
- Class moms will provide snacks.
